

“My natural teeth had been a source of embarrassment and pain for many years. The embarrassment was difficult enough to deal with but the pain was excruciating at times.

I will never forget waking up in early 2002 and discovering that several of the crowns in the front were loose. My biggest fear was having my teeth fall out while talking. Over a period of less than ten years, despite my vigilant upkeep, the gum tissue recessed to the point of no repair and the bone deteriorated rapidly as well. I felt that there were no affordable or effective solutions with any type of duration of stability. I finally had to accept the inevitable and had to have all of my teeth removed (and get dentures).

I initially decided to go to Dr. Argeros for an exam and appraisal of my dentures and to find out price, aesthetic appeal (natural looking), and options available. I was aware that the health of my mouth affected my over all health and well being.

I feel that I was provided with the latest state of the art technology and information at a reasonable cost overall, everything considered.
